We had a program like this 7 years ago, but only had a couple hundred residents signed up to use it. He is hoping this time many more people will sign up.

He asked for a motion to approve Thanksgiving gift cards for Village employees. Last year, the amounts were \$50 for full time and \$25 for part-time employees. Trustee Bowers suggested the amounts be increased to \$100 and \$50 because of inflation. Trustee Weyeneth made a motion for the increased amounts with Trustee Schierer seconding. With a vote of 6 yeas and 0 nays, the motion passed.
