## Mayor's Report

Mayor Cummings reminded the Board that the Police Union contract negotiations will start soon. The contract is up in the spring.

He asked for a motion to approve the Village's sponsorship of the "Metamora Hometown Christmas" which will be held December 8<sup>th</sup>, in the amount NTE \$1500.00. Trustee Alig made a motion for approval with Trustee Nauman seconding. With a vote of 3 yeas, 1 abstain (Schierer) and 0 nays, the motion passed.

This program would be free to our residents, but they would have to sign up to receive text messages from the Village. After a short discussion,

Trustee Nauman made a motion to approve the program with Trustee Schierer seconding. With a vote of 4 yeas and 0 nays, the motion passed.

Next, Mayor Cummings informed the Board he had a meeting with the library. They asked if the Village would be interested in selling the property where the Legion originally stood. They would like to purchase it for a future building site of a new library. He asked the Board to consider the possibility.
